

Step 1: Mobile Registrations

On a search engine (best to use is Chrome): follow the link provided and type the URL noelauctioneers.hibid.com.

Once loaded, your phone screen should look something like this:

Step 2: Mobile Registration




From the main page, in the top right corner is a little person; click this button.

Fill in the blanks as necessary:




Enter a valid phone number

Scroll through all fields, then click Create New Account






Step 4: Mobile Registration

Click Log On.




Step 5: Mobile Registration

The catalogue button will take you to the lots to view; when clicking on lots, it will open the additional images and, when scrolling, give you a description.


Please note the auction details will provide Terms & Conditions as well as pick up dates and times.


Step 6: Mobile Registration



Select Manage Payment Methods. Enter the card you want to use, and select Save. If you wish to leave a note, do so here.

Read the terms and check <u>Accept</u>, then <u>Submit Registration</u>.

Once selecting Register to Bid - it will ask for an active credit card or debit card that can be verified. This is used only when given authorization at pickup, shipping, or for late pickups.



Step 7: Mobile Registration

Once the card goes through, you're done!

A pop up will appear for a successful registration. Just select OK. You will get an email confirmation.

HAPPY BIDDING!!

Select Bid \$5 or what amount needs to be bid to claim the winning bid. A pop up will appear to let you enter a MAX BID. This allows you to enter the amount you are willing to pay before the 6% tax and BP. The system will auto bid for you until your max is met or until others stop bidding.


Step 8 : Mobile Registration

After logging in: the Body icon in the top right corner will provide a drop menu of access to your bidding experience.

<u>Current bids</u> will reflect anything you have already registered and bid on.

Watch list reflects the items you STAR for tracking during the auction without bidding on that item.

In this, you can also update your cards and account information as needed.



Tips & Tricks

MAX BID: Amount you are willing to pay before tax & BP. Placing a max bid allows the system to bid in your place until your max is outbid.

<u>PENDING</u>: If your bids show orange/yellow for pending, please allow 24-48 hours for the auctioneer to review the account and accept your bids. This usually only happens for new registrations.

WINNING BID: If your bid shows green for winning bid, then you currently have the high bid.

<u>OUT BID</u>: If your bid shows red, then you have been outbid, and the system will prompt you to increase your bid to potentially become the high bidder again.

<u>SOFT CLOSE</u>: The auction will BEGIN to close on the set date and time. This means 5 lots will close about 25 seconds apart from the next five. If you add a bid to the lot as it closes, more time will be added to the lot. Once bidding stops, the item will time down and close.

MAY HAVE WON: At the end of the auction, if you were the high bidder, the auction will highlight the lots in green as MAY HAVE WON. You will receive your invoice within the following 24 hours that should reflect the items with the high bid. Noel Auctioneers will review the invoices and items before sending the final list to you in order to ensure there were no reserves or issues with the lot. Please be patient.
